There are a couple of safeguarding updates that the 2 Johns our e-safety experts have asked me to pass on to you. Firstly, Musical.ly the popular video app has changed it's name to Tik Tok. The functions are still the same and it is very popular with peadophiles who pose as youngsters to gain access to children's accounts.

Secondly, there are increasing concerns around Roblox and the amount of sexual content that is appearing in some of the role play sessions. Please keep a eye on the children's settings when allowing children to use this game.

The usual 2 Johns advice remains. DO NOT ban children from using these apps and games but remind them about being safe on the internet and how to report anything that upsets them. We will continue to do they same in school.
