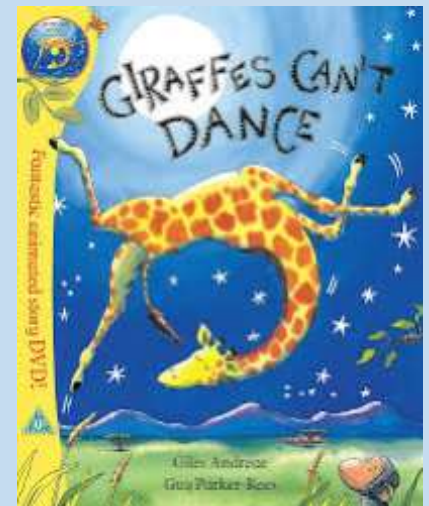


BOOK RECOMMENDATION

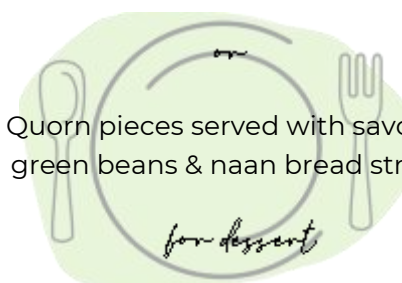

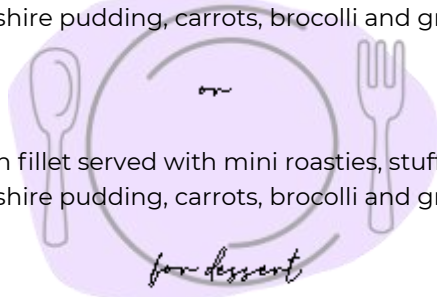

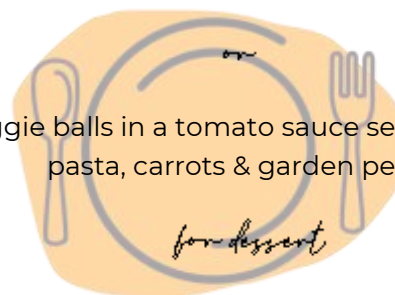
