She has started an amazing IV treatment which we have to regularly visit hospital for. She has been a superstar!


Emily's weight has increased and she's back to her usual happy, energetic self which we hope continues and the disease can be successfully managed long term.

FROM THE CLASSROOM OF...PENGUINS






