What is child protection about?

At Rodings Primary School all of the adults around you think your health, safety and well-being are very important. In our school we respect all children and want to keep them safe and help to protect their rights.



We do our best to help children make good educational progress.

We teach children how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

Our core values *Respect*, **INJOYMENT**, *Care*, **Confidence** and **Challenge** are there to protect you.

How will we try to protect children?

We try to provide a safe environment for children to learn in. We want to ensure that children remain safe, at home and at school.

We think it is important for our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

If you need to talk - we will listen! You can talk to any adult in school. It is **Mr Raraty's** special job to keep you safe - talk to him if you are worried. **Mr Crawley** and **Mrs Paget** also have a special job to keep you safe too.

Remember you can always use a worry box as well.



Tell a friend and then go with your friend to tell an adult.

Use Childline too.

A teacher could also help you speak to your parents, if you are worried about doing it alone.

Don't keep it secret if:

- Someone is bullying you
- Saying funny things to you that you do not like or upsets you
- Touching you in a way you don't like
- Trying to give you medicine when you are not ill, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol
- Hitting you or hurting you
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.
